

**Vodafone R&D –**  
**Historical Events, Summary Outline, V1.01**

**2009**

1. VF Foundation Americas Wireless Innovation Contest – Technology which was considered “too futuristic” to be allowed entry, not good enough to make “finals”?
2. VF R&D Director – who invoked invalid, compromised R&D Due Diligence conclusion, in response to my’ requesting assistance from VF CEO Mr. Sarun in 2008 – was Central Figure/Technical Judge in the VF Foundation Americas Wireless Innovation Contest.

**Question:** *Is there a relation between initially having been denied entry in the contest because technology was considered by VF tech experts as “too futuristic” for me to be able to develop proof of concept within 3 years/by 2011, when in fact, I had already developed them since 3 years earlier, and entrusted source to VF R&D since 2007?.....is there a connection between having been initially denied entry because “too futuristic”, then not even making the finals – with 3 breakthrough projects – 2 of which already commended/shared source with VF R&D.....because the VF R&D Director was the main decision-maker for “this” contest?*

**NOTE:** *“Success” in the Wireless Innovation Contest in 2009 might have required justification from Vodafone R&D Director/Leaders - why Vodafone shareholders may have been deprived considerable additional revenue for the past years – i.e., in the range of “billions” - as innovation opportunity had already been presented to VF R&D since 2006...followed by a series of highly questionable actions and events?*
