

**Vodafone R&D Leaders, Correcting "Mistake" –
– i.e., Presenting Purpose/Good Intentions – Leading to Obtaining Source Code**

Due Diligence Compromised Conclusion Triggered Objections, i.e.:

6/6/07 Razz Van: David (*Vodafone R&D Leader1*), I would like to reinforce again that we do have a demo you can look at, for a number of the applications claimed by OM. I have reinforced this point starting as early as 9 months ago. Within this scope, I am inviting you and/or Paco to Romania/NY...or UK to go over it. If there is confusion as to the number of applications enabled by the OM solution, this should not be viewed as weakness, but rather as significant potential for additional releases down the line. We do not plan to launch all at once, unless the resources and the interest for this existed.

October 4, 2007 Vodafone R&D Leader1: Razz - Re terminal OS etc do you envisage a standalone client app or is the request always constructed over a WAP session back to the network? Is this what you are saying? I will speak to our terminals guru in R&D to see how he thinks the architecture should be so that we can get this on some real devices so we can put together the DELL model. What do you think?

08 October 2007 Razz Van: Hi David (*Vodafone R&D Leader1:* "Files attached – Confidential"), I am attaching 2 files - a zip file (Demo), and a ReadMe doc. The zip file contains the source files for running a Offer/Request WAP demo on the Dell example. Let me know when you receive these files?

10/8/07 Vodafone R&D Leader1: Razz- I have this. Thanks.

10/25/07 Vodafone R&D Leader1 (cc Leader3): I am now in discussion with the Head of our web and media activities Gunther Weber (Leader3) and things are looking very encouraging for getting some traction on building a demonstration platform. Thank you for your continued patience.

10/25/07 Vodafone R&D Leader1: Razz, I am currently keeping focus on the search element of the OM solution. The challenge that you present us with is if we look at security and counterfeit I must engage with VF experts in a different field. From a due diligence perspective we then need to do separate analysis. I am not saying that I can't or won't but please appreciate the subtlety of the challenge of assessing OM in this way. Please give me some time to consider your proposals.

November 1, 2007 Razz Van (cc Vodafone R&D Leader1, OM Executive): Mr. Weber (*Vodafone R&D Leader3*), I am contacting you courtesy of Mr. David Leftley (*Vodafone R&D Leader1*) - I want to verify with you if the OneMany demo/source code sent along with the accompanying files are helpful in getting some meaningful results, and to mention that if you need my assistance in any way, please do not hesitate

November 2, 2007 Vodafone R&D Leader3: Dear Razz, thank you for your mail. I will come back to you during the next week.

November 28, 2007 Razz Van: Good morning David (*VF R&D Leader1*), I've been unable to contact you or Guenther for the last few weeks, and hence I am not sure if we are progressing and converging on the same view regarding the immense OneMany potential, Vodafone as a fundamental partner

4 December 2007 Razz Van: Good morning David, I am under some pressure, as Catalin (Computer Science & Artificial Intelligence Professor) considers that the delay is artificial, finding it inconceivable that highly skilled technical professionals from Web/Media R&D cannot validate the technical claims and assess the value considering the information shared, its uniqueness, potential value and potential impact...or that they will not make a focused effort to play a constructive role considering the unique benefits the proposed technology can have for VF.

4 December 2007 Razz Van: Good morning David (*Vodafone R&D Leader1*), - I've tried on a number of occasions during the last month or two to contact Guenther (*Vodafone R&D Leader3*) offering to support in any way his testing, or be available for any questions in case of problems. No feedback...so I rhetorically assume that there are no problems? the proposed solutions are impossible to fail testing. They are mathematical truths, also proven in my simulations. However, an inadequate understanding may result most likely in less-than-success. Remember what happened when Paco tried to build a demo without me being aware of it, or asking me for my source, or the proper directions.

December 5, 2007 Vodafone R&D Leader1 (cc Vodafone R&D Leader3): Razz - Guenther is a very insightful and experienced man. After reading your business plan, he identified the opportunity of the technology in relatively short period of time, grasping the concept quicker than most. I assure you on his behalf that any delays are simply resource related.

1/31/08 Vodafone R&D Leader1: Razz - You have a search related product. It may seem totally illogical but my job would be easier if you were invested in by Google.

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09 February 2009 Razz Van: David (*Vodafone R&D Leader1*) - My understanding at the time was that any kind of constructive action was desired in order to get the ball rolling, stuff evaluated...it had already been a while without events since I had sent Gunther the source code for a demo...More can be said that will bring in a new light on past events.
